Scholarships

Scholarship monies will be sent directly to the college/university named in the applicant's documents to be applied towards tuition.

Deadline

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Applicant must be a United States citizen.
- 2. Applicant must be a Highmark Credit Union member.
- 3. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- 4. Applicant must be planning to attend a two or four year post-secondary accredited university or a technical/vocational school.

Application Requirements

- 1. A completed copy of the Highmark High School Financial Scholarship application form, including:
 - a. List of volunteer work/job experience
 - b. List of extracurricular activities/organizations
 - c. List of accomplishments, honors, and awards
- 2. A written letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, community leader, or supervisor.
- 3. An essay, not to exceed 500 words, on the following question: "Please explain how your experiences volunteering and participating in your local community have influenced your future ambitions and/or career choice."

Judging Criteria

The judging committee will score each applicant based on the following criteria:

- 1. Volunteer work/job experience
- 2. Extracurricular activities/organizations
- 3. Accomplishments, honors and awards
- 4. Letter of recommendation
- 5. Essay
